Introduction

This list is related to the proposed “Big Dig” to be held at Burpham in 2024. Due to the nature of the site, for the Anglo-Saxon burgh at Burpham the list focuses on the Middle and (especially) the Late Anglo-Saxon period. (650-1066 AD).

Also, given that the current settlement at Burpham lies outside the boundary of the burgh, this reading list also includes items relating to Anglo-Norman, Early Medieval, and 11th-12th century rural settlements.

In terms of the literature, there is a movement to use the term ‘Early Medieval’ to cover the period from 500 – 1066 AD.
